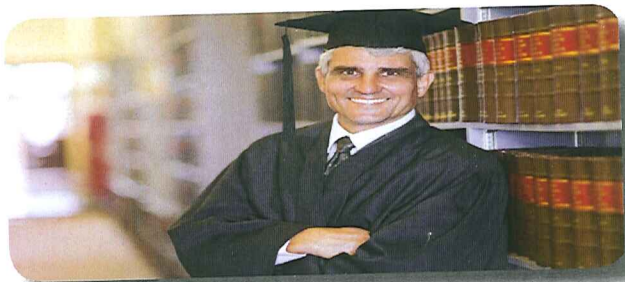
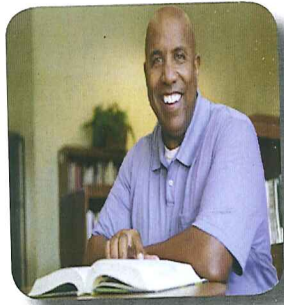
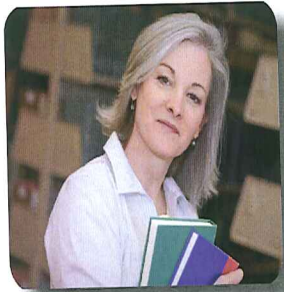


# Adult Learners

## How does the Virtual Learning Center approach differ from other virtual programs?

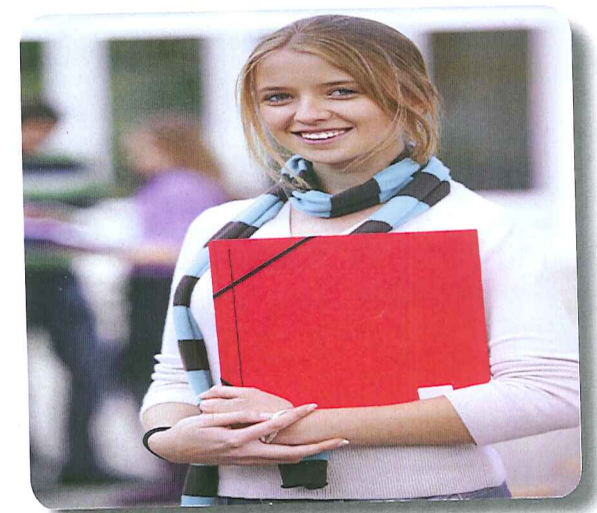
Education is not a one-size-fits-all endeavor, and that awareness has resulted in a need for creative ways to customize resources for the learner.

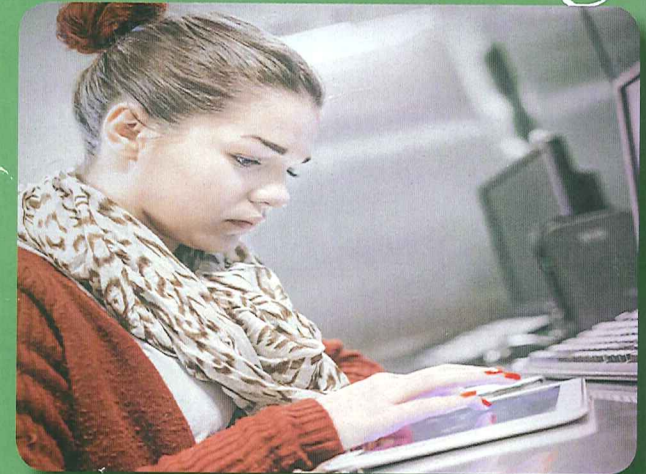
