Dear Mr. Pegram:

Opaa! Food Management, Inc. would respectfully like to request that the Santa Fe Trail USD 434 School District Board of Education extend our Food Service Management agreement for the 2014-15 school year. This is the first of four extension renewal requests allowed before another bid process is required to be initiated.

Opaa! Food Management, Inc., will fulfill its obligations under the same terms and conditions of our base year agreement dated June 12, 2013.

Attached you will find a contract addendum detailing the prices to be charged for the 2014-2015 school year.

As per our agreement, written notice of such extension is to be made to Opaa! Food Management, Incorporated, on or before the first day of June annually. The Kansas State Department of Education requests that an executed copy of the enclosed addendum be forwarded to, Child Nutrition & Wellness, Attn: Judy Neely, Consultant, 120 SE 10th Avenue, Topeka, KS. 66612-1182.

The original addendum we sent to you dated April 16th contained a clause stating that extra milks taken by students outside of the reimbursable meal program would be billed to the district at 38 cents per unit. This revenue (Opaa! Revenue) would then be included in the A la Carte revenue sharing formula based on the meal equivalency factor. We have been using that practice in our other Districts outside of Kansas and the result is that both the District and the Food Service Management Company receive their fair share of revenue. Opaa! is simply trying to recover its cost of acquisition and distribution of milk to the students. KSDE has informed us that this process in not allowable in Kansas.

Steve Adams will be in touch with you to discuss this situation and propose a solution that is mutually agreeable.

The cooperation we have received from students, parents, staff and administration have contributed to a successful food service program. We appreciate their input and look forward to providing Santa Fe Trail USD 434 School District with the highest quality food service for the 2014 - 2015 school year.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Breakfast meal fee for SY 2014-2015 is (price) \$ 1.0708.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Breakfast management fee for SY 2014-2015 is (price) \$ 0.1568.

The cost to the Sponsor for the **Snack meal fee** for SY 2014-2015 is (price) \$N/A.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Snack management fee for SY 2014-2015 is (price) \$ N/A.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Meal equivalent fee for SY 2014-2015 is (price) \$ 3.2608.

This amendment is effective **July 1, 2014** and thereafter, unless otherwise amended. All other terms and conditions contained in the Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
