READING FLUENCY AT HOME

Reading Fluency is a child's ability to read on grade level text accurately, quickly, and with expression. This is a skill that can be practiced at home. Here are a few strategies to try:

- Echo Reading Read a sentence and have your child repeat the sentence back to you using the same expression and pauses
- Choral Reading Read a book or passage with your child in unison, aloud
- Record It Play the game of creating an audiobook with your child. Record it and play it back so your child can hear what his or her audiobook sounds like. You can also share the finalized audiobook with other family members to add some extra motivation and praise
