

ACT ASSESSMENT BOGO OPPORTUNITY

The ACT, a key test for U.S. college admissions, evaluates students in English, math, reading, and science, with an optional writing component, and scores range from 1 to 36 in each subject. Many U.S. colleges consider ACT scores for admissions, alongside the SAT or test-optional policies. Students can pick their ACT test date and should check college-specific requirements regarding the optional writing section.
