Subject: Opening of School Report

Once again the beginning of the year has been going great at Overbrook. Our students are getting used to their routines and everyone is getting settled in.

Enrollment

The table below lists the enrollment headcount as of September 4, 2015.

This number is 22 more students than we had last September. The number will change during the school year, but we have some nice, large class sizes as of right now. Also one of the first grade students is a part time student that is home schooled, but participates in our specials.

August Before-School Activities

The pre-service days were quite busy. Meetings included: opening staff meeting, training on Aimsweb, training on Lexia, training on MTSS.

We had a good turnout for open house on August 24th. Students were able to bring in classroom supplies and meet their teachers, along with the parents getting to see their child's new classroom.

Morning and Afternoon Transportation Routines

We followed the same routine as the last few years, which was placing the colored wristbands on backpacks when students came to Open House. We wrote the student's name and an emergency number on the band. We also called about twenty families to confirm transportation plans before the end of school on the 25th of August. We had a little confusion from a few kindergartens the first day, but things overall ran very smoothly.

Lexia

We started this reading program this week. So far it has been going really well. The first step is to be assessed on the reading program. After the assessment students then log on to the program throughout the week and work on their reading skills. The program adjusts to the students reading levels, and lets the teacher know if interventions

are needed. This program also offers us a lot of reading data, which the staff will be able to share with the parents at conference time.

Upcoming Activities

The big event coming up at OAC is the picnic on the playground, in place of grandparent's day. It is scheduled for Friday, September 25th with a rainout day for October 9th. We have asked students to invite people that are special to them to the picnic. This can include grandparents, family members, or even a family friend. We did a picnic last year with great success, so we are trying again this year. The book fair will also be set up in the library, so guests will be able to purchase books if they wish.
