Everything at Overbrook has been going well so far. We really enjoyed going to the homecoming parade this year downtown. The students also had a lot of fun at the pep rally.

Lexia

The numbers are in from our first month of using the Lexia reading program. I cannot say I am happy about the numbers, but the numbers do show where our students need help.

The numbers below show you how many students we have in each grade level, and what grade level Lexia has each student placed.

Kindergarten -78 Students

PreK – 51 - 65%

Kind – 27 - 35%

1st Grade – 85 Students

PreK – 5 - 6%

Kind. – 66 - 78%

1st or above – 14 - 16%

2nd Grade – 66 Students

Kind. – 12 students - 18%

1st – 36 students - 55%

2nd or above – 18 students = 27%

Lexia has given us some great data, to show us what our students need to work on. The students are able to use Lexia at both school and home, and our hope is that the parents will encourage their students to practice at home. We plan to go over the individual student data at conferences with the parents.

Kansas Reading Road Map

We continue to follow the parts of this grant. We have the afterschool and Family and Schools Together (FAST) program in place. We also are implementing Multi-Tier System of Supports (MTSS). The afterschool program currently has 30 students and we are inviting more students weekly.

Parent/Teacher Conferences

Fall conferences at OAC are scheduled for October 26 and 28 from 4:00-7:00. We look forward to visiting with parents about their student's progress.
