SAC Yearbooks

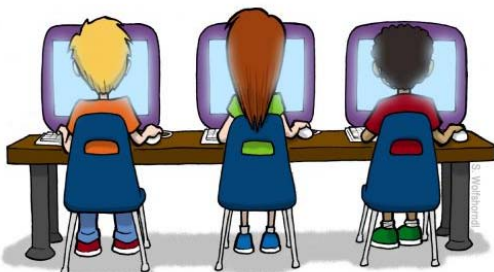
The window to order 2015-2016 yearbooks is coming to a
