ADDENDUM TO RENEW FIXED PRICE FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT

This addendum is between the Sponsor, Santa Fe Trail USD 434 and

Contractor, Opaa! Food Management of KS, LLC. The Parties now hereto agree as follows:

This term of this Contract shall be for One (1) year beginning on **July 1, 2016** and continuing until **June 30, 2017** unless terminated by either party as provided.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Lunch meal fee for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$ 1.7427.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Lunch management fee for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$ 0.2553.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Breakfast meal fee for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$ 1.1305.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Breakfast management fee for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$ 0.1654.

The cost to the Sponsor for the **Snack meal fee** for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$_____.

The cost to the Sponsor for the **Snack management fee** for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$_____.

The cost to the Sponsor for the Meal equivalent factor for SY 2016-2017 is (price) \$ 3.4426.

Amendments as required by USDA include:

- 1. All new and current employees of the CONTRACTOR will meet minimum continuing education standards as specified in the Professional Standards Final Rule at http://www.fns.usda.gov/school-meals/professional-standards. The CONTRACTOR shall also comply with the hiring and education standards for new Food Service Directors as specified in the Professional Standards Rule. The CONTRACTOR must provide documentation to the SPONSOR to show compliance with the annual training requirements of the Professional Standards Final Rule. Such documentation shall include training hours and topics completed by the employees of the CONTRACTOR. All training costs incurred by the CONTRACTOR shall not be passed on to the SPONSOR and are the responsibility of the CONTRACTOR.
- 2. Per 7 CFR Part 210.14(f), Sponsors must comply with the nonprogram foods and revenue requirements, therefore; per SP 20-2016 the CONTRACTOR will annually provide to the SPONSOR information on food costs and revenues. The information must include food cost for reimbursable meals, food cost for non-program foods, revenue from non-program foods, and total revenue. Nonprogram foods include: a la carte; catering; vending; and student stores operated, or any other sales generated through the nonprofit school food service account not already described.

This amendment is effective **July 1, 2016** and thereafter, unless otherwise amended. All other terms and conditions contained in the Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
