We are having an exciting year at Overbrook. Teachers have been working very hard and we are seeing some great growth from some of our students.

The numbers are in from our first full month of using the Lexia reading program. We have already made some great gains in the program.

The numbers below show you how each grade level is doing and what grade level the students are testing at on Lexia.
