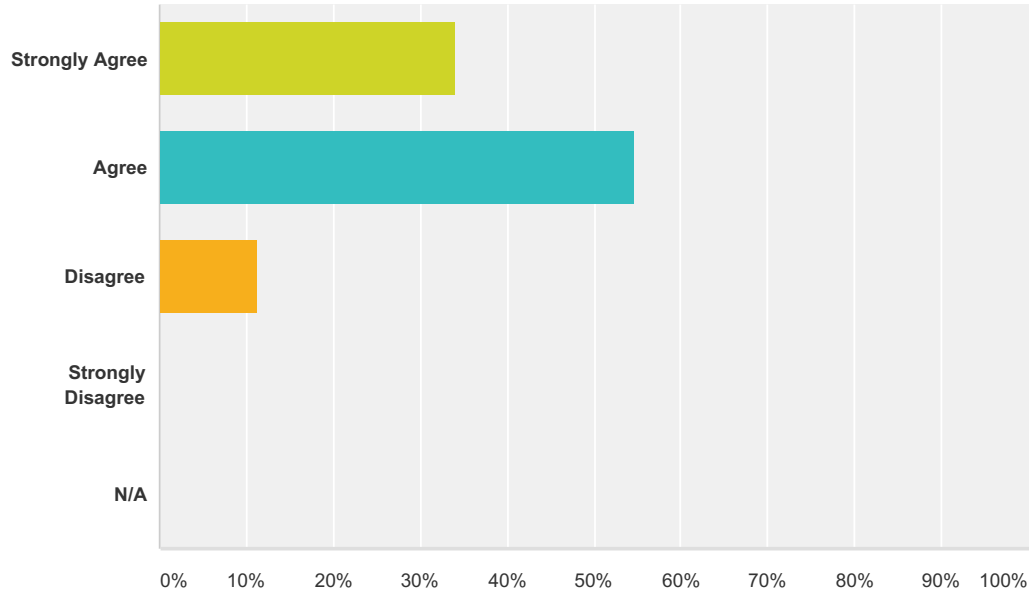


Q1 When I walk into the school, I feel the school is inviting and that this is a place where parents "belong."

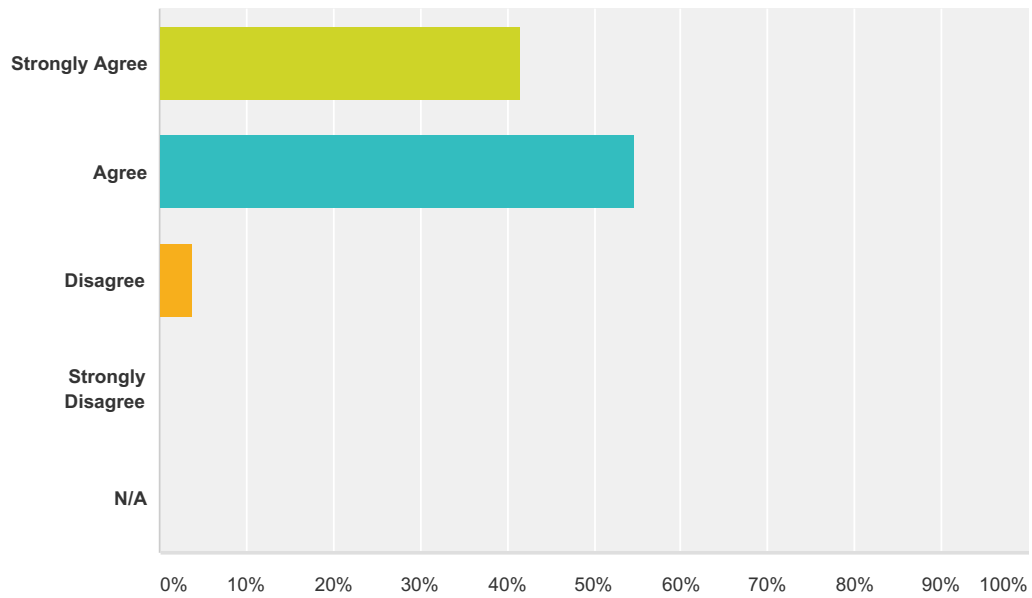

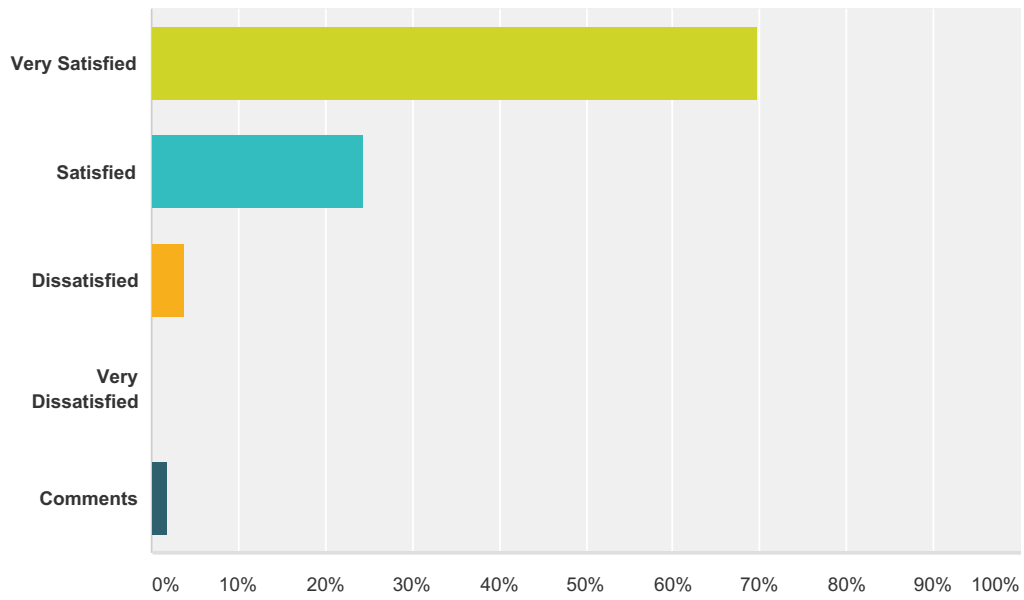

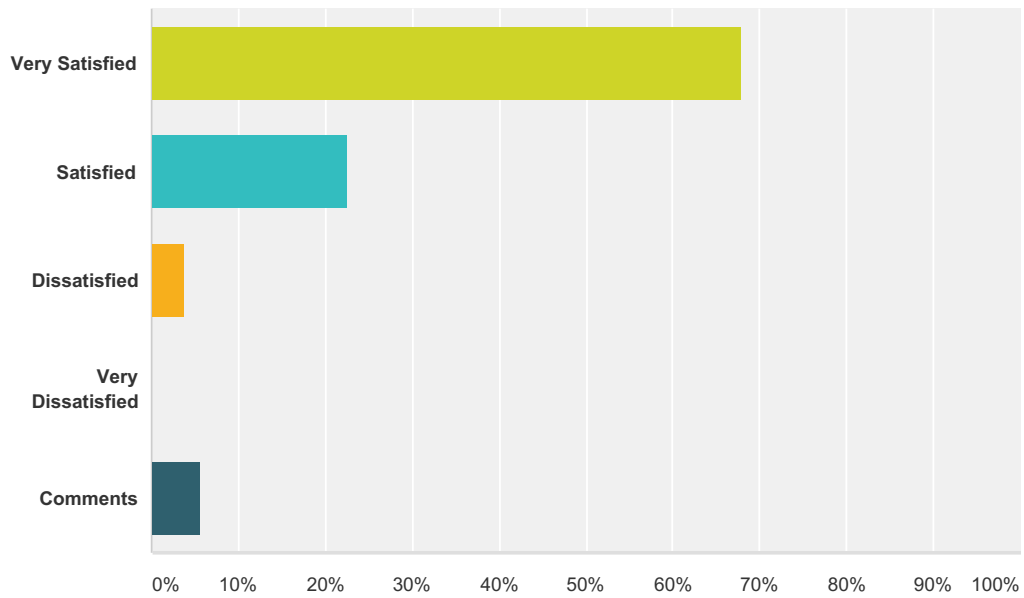

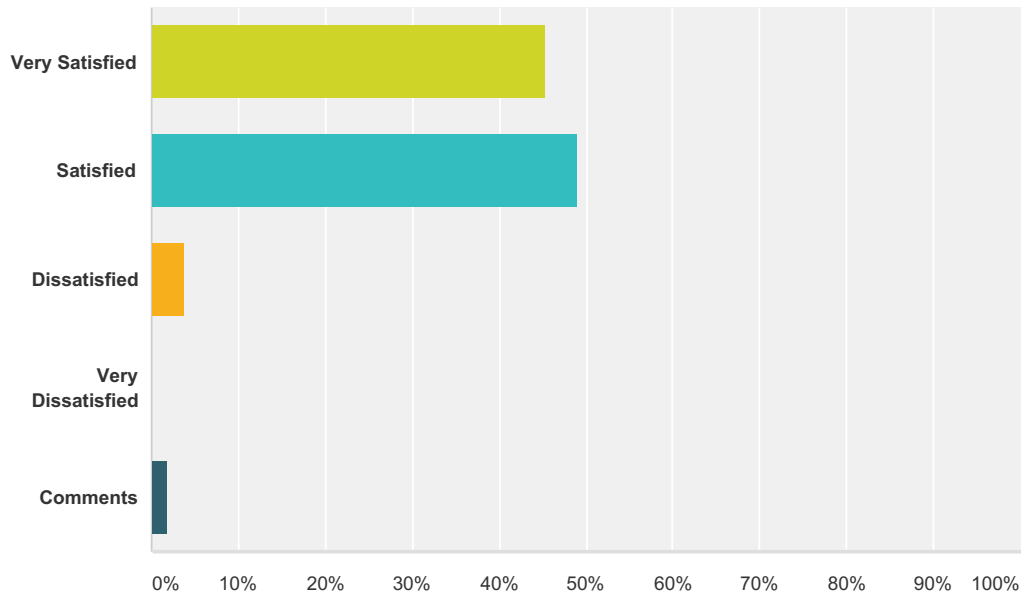

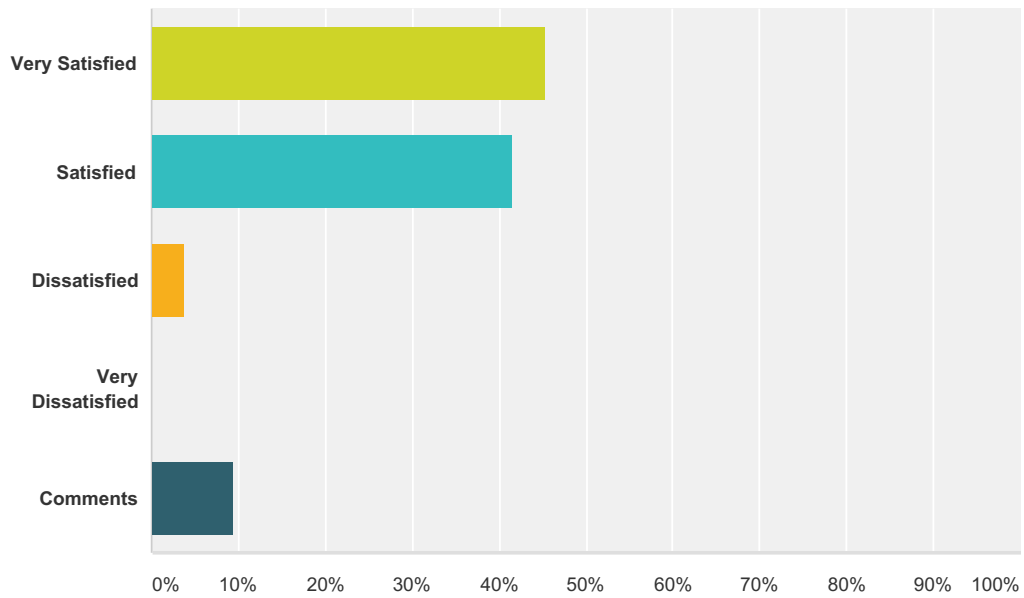

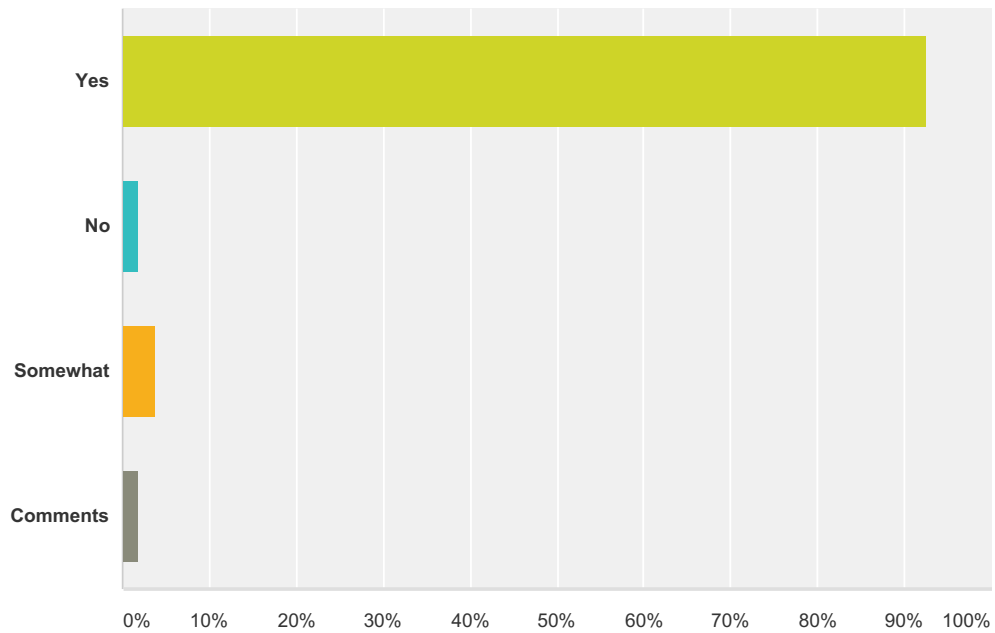

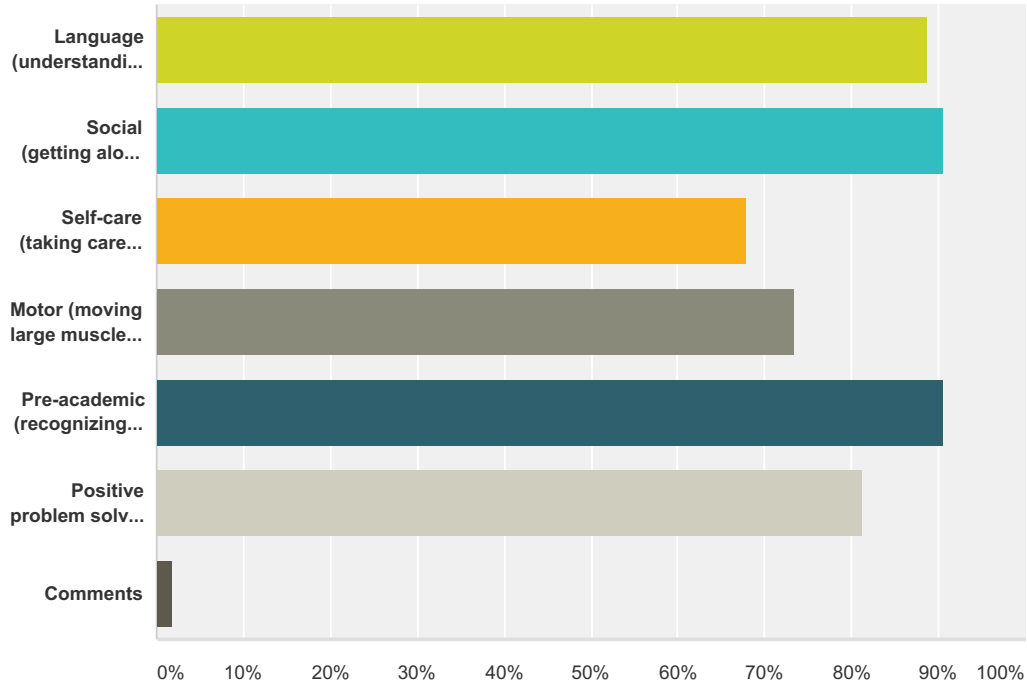
