# Wrestling

The Chargers begin their season on Thursday, December 5<sup>th</sup> when we host Eudora. The next day, they travel to Spring Hill for a very tough dual tournament on Friday, December 6<sup>th</sup>. The Spring Hill dual tournament is a big school vs. small school format. There are 29 wrestlers and 5 managers on the team this year. Of the 29 wrestlers this year, 6 are girls. Girls wrestling is now a championship sport in the state of Kansas. This past April, the board of directors of KSHSAA, the Kansas State High School Activities Association, approved the introduction of girls wrestling.

The girl's team will see their first action this Friday at Burlington. Santa Fe Trail will host a Junior Varsity Tournament on Friday, December 13<sup>th</sup> and then head to Anderson County for a Varsity Tournament on Saturday, December 14<sup>th</sup>. SFT hosts Ottawa and Tonganoxie Thursday, December 19<sup>th</sup> starting at 5:00 pm.

#### Basketball

The SFT boys' team has 28 players out this season, plus 9 managers and the girls' team consists of 17 players and 3 managers. On Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup> the Chargers will open up the season with the varsity teams in action in the Ike Cearfoss – Central Heights Tournament, an early season tournament. SFTHS is a host site on that Monday and then again on Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup>. On Tuesday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, the "C" boys, JV boys and JV girls will host West Franklin. Each team will open the Pioneer League season when we host Prairie View on Tuesday, December 17<sup>th</sup>. This night will close out all games prior to the break. The boys and the girls will both have freshmen, junior varsity and varsity teams again this year. Games are normally played on Tuesdays and Fridays. When the teams are at home, games are played at Santa Fe Trail High School main and dome gyms.
