Wearing Masks or Face Coverings

The district will follow the guidelines established by Executive Oder 20-59. This includes all classrooms and public spaces inside or outside the building with the following exceptions.

- 1. Students involved in strenuous physical activities during physical education may remove their masks during the activity. Students standing or sitting and receiving instruction during PE class and students entering or leaving the gym are required to wear masks. Teachers and other personnel are required to wear masks at all times when working with students.
- 2. Elementary students may remove their masks during outdoor recess when involved in strenuous physical activity. Teachers and other personnel are required to wear masks at all times when working with students.
- 3. Students involved in KSHSAA sponsored activities/athletics will follow the rules and regulations established by KSHSAA. Students who are not directly involved in strenuous physical activity should wear masks/face covering. Examples include sitting on the bench. Standing on the sidelines or receiving instructions. All coaches and sponsors are expected to know and follow all KSHSAA regulations. Coaches and sponsors are required to wear masks at all time when working with students.
- 4. Students with a medical condition, mental health condition or disability that prevents wearing a mask must have a note from a doctor that specifically states the existing condition that would excuse them from wearing a mask.
