On February 5th, the girls' wrestlers competed at Districts in Burlingame. All 5 qualified for Regionals in Rossville on February 13th. Three of the 5 qualified for Sub State at Anderson County on 2/19. SFT had one place 5th and one 6th, so the girls' season has finished as well.

The sub state tournament is at Council Grove. The girls will play the first round Monday March 1st at Silver Lake High School, at 7:00 pm. The second round will be Thursday and Friday, and the championship games will be played Saturday, all at Council Grove High School.
