Baseball

The baseball team has gotten off to a perfect start sitting at 6-0. The JV is also sporting a 4-0 record. The JV typically plays on Monday nights, and the Varsity on Tuesday nights. The team has 19 players. There are no spectator limits, although masks are still required on

entry, and when unable to socially distance. This is consistent with all spring sports. Regionals this year will be hosted by Oskaloosa, however the number 1 and 2 seed will host the first two rounds of the 8-team bracket on 5/17, with Oskaloosa hosting the final game on 5/19. Hiawatha, Easton-Pleasant Ridge, Royal Valley, Jeff West, Perry, Santa Fe Trail, Bishop Ward, and Oskaloosa are the teams in the regional. The state tournament will be held at Kansas State University, on May 27-28.

Softball

The softball team has had a great turnout, with 28 players participating. The varsity is currently 2-4, while the JV is 0-4. Both JV and Varsity teams typically play double headers on Tuesday nights. The 8-team regional host is Silver Lake. The higher seeded team will host the quarter final round of regionals on May 17th, the Silver Lake will host the semi-final and final game to determine who will advance to the state tournament. Silver Lake, Perry, Jeff West, Oskaloosa, KC Bishop Ward, Royal Valley, Santa Fe Trail, and Pleasant Ridge are the teams in the Regional. The state tournament will be held in Manhattan at the Twin Oakes Complex on May 27-28.

Boys Golf

The boys golf team couldn't have started much better. The Chargers have blown away the competition, winning both tournaments by 30+ strokes, and have had 3 of 4 top medalists, including the tournament champion in both outings. The JV has competed in one tournament, in which they had three individuals medal. There are 14 golfers this year. Regionals will be at Osawatomie, and the teams are Burlington HS; Carbondale-Santa Fe Trail HS; Council Grove HS; Garnett-Anderson County HS; LaCygne-Prairie View HS; Osage City HS; Osawatomie HS; Perry-Lecompton HS; Pomona-West Franklin HS; Wellsville HS. The state tournament will be held at the Hesston Golf Course on May 24-25.

Track & Field

The Santa Fe Trail track team broke two school records at their very first meet of the season on April 1st, in Silver Lake. Both the varsity and JV competed. Brett Schwartz broke his own discus record, and Ryan Weekley broke the 100m dash record. The track team has 25 boys and 24 girls participating. Regionals will be at Osage City, with the following teams competing: Council Grove HS, Pleasant Ridge, Royal Valley, Bishop Ward, Prairie View, Jeff West, Osage City, Osawatomie, Oskaloosa, Perry Lecompton, West Franklin, Rossville, Silver Lake, St. Mary's, and Wellsville. The top four in each event will qualify for the 3A state championship in Wichita, on May 28th.
