The coordinator will work under the guidance of the Curriculum Director with supervision from the Building Principal. Responsibilities include but are not limited to developing curriculum, professional development, and the implementation of innovative instructional practices, including problem-based learning, student leadership, innovative courses, integrated instruction, and implementation of STREAM (Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Art, and Math) design.

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- Collaborate regularly with teaching teams to develop grade level curricular connections as requested by the grade level teams, to discuss implementation of inquiry/project based learning in the classroom, and to provide support for implementation.
- Work closely with building level PLCs to facilitate the development and implementation of innovative instructional practices across grades.
- Manage and coordinate projects, tasks, and collect data under the guidance of the Curriculum Director/Building Principal.
- Provide innovative learning experiences for students as part of the current Specials Rotation.
- Review literature, prepare and annotate reports and data source materials as needed to support projects and professional development.
- Provide training for staff in innovative STREAM instructional practices.
- Assist with the selection and purchase of supplemental curriculum resources, professional development, and supplies for the STREAM program at OAC.
- Assist with coordinating and/or providing training for innovative best practices and monitor the implementation within OAC.
- Communicate school successes to all stakeholders.

Extended Contract Required
