Athletics and Activities at Santa Fe Trail High School

Baseball

The varsity team has an overall record of 11-5 this season. The junior varsity is 12-2 on the season. Santa Fe Trail will travel to Kansas City-Bishop Ward on Tuesday, May 19th for Regional Baseball. The Regional will be played at the 1st or 2nd seeded team, TBD on May 12th, on May 17th. Winners will advance to play at Oskaloosa on May 19th.

Softball

The varsity softball team has an overall record of 9-9 so far this year and the junior varsity has 1 win and 13 losses. The top 4 seeds will host the first-round games on May 17th, with the winners playing the following day in Silver Lake. Seeds will be determined on May 12th.

Boys Golf

SFT has been making a lot of noise this season. Trail has won all 5 tournaments they have been in, and had the tournament champion in 4 of those. They also have had 4 to 5 golfers finish in the top 10 in these tournaments. Golf regionals are in Osawatomie on May 17th, with State being in Hesston on May 24-25th.

Track

The Santa Fe Trail track team has also enjoyed great success. SFT track records have been broken 3 times this year, as well as many personal records broken every meet. The Pioneer League Track Meet will be at Burlington on May 13th beginning at 3:30 pm. Regionals this year are at Osage City on May 21st. The state meet format has changed this year. 3A will compete on May 28th only, at Cessna Stadium in Wichita.

Summer Weights and Conditioning

Weights and conditioning begins on Monday, June 7th. It is offered in the mornings for high school boys from 7:00am-8:00am, high school girls from 8:00am-9:00am, and junior high students from 9:00a-10:00am, on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
