Professional Development

USD 434 teachers and staff will participate in continued SEL professional development on February 21st. Educators are in an ongoing process of learning about the foundations of social-emotional learning, neurosequential model, toxic stress, strategies to support students, and adult SEL and wellness. This month the district will participate in a poverty simulation. This simulation will give our staff an immersive experience into the life of poverty and how to better support our students and families. This experience will provide an insight into crisis, trauma, and perseverance that every educator will find valuable.

Math Curriculum

The K-5 Math Committee will meet again this month to collaborate with middle/secondary teachers. The goal for this meeting is to create K-12 alignment, discuss best practices in mathematics, create a vetting process for resource adoption, and plan for a pilot program. This team has done amazing work and concentrated on the areas of improvement for district mathematics education. I thank them for all of their hard work.

District Leadership Team
