As a collaborative team we set building goals as included below. We are in the process of writing action plans for our goals which will include consistent data reviews.

Goal 1: CAC WILL IMPROVE THE POSITIVE BEHAVIOR SUPPORT SYSTEM TO PROMOTE SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL WELLNESS FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF.

Goal 2: CAC STUDENTS WILL DEMONSTRATE 10% ACADEMIC GROWTH FROM LEVEL 1 TO LEVEL 2 AS EVIDENCED ON STATE ELA, MATH, AND SCIENCE ASSESSMENTS.

Goal 3: CAC STAFF WILL DECREASE OUR SAEBRS HIGH RISK GROUP STUDENT NUMBERS BY 5% BEFORE THE END OF THE 22/23 SCHOOL YEAR.

Goal 4: By May 2023, CAC STAFF WILL DEMONSTRATE PROGRESS IN IMPLEMENTATION OF A MULTI-TIERED SYSTEM OF SUPPORT (MTSS) FRAMEWORK THAT USES COMMON AND RELIABLE DATA TO PROVIDE MATH AND READING INSTRUCTION THAT IS RESEARCH-BASED AND DIFFERENTIATED TO MEET THE LEARNING NEEDS OF ALL STUDENTS. THIS IMPLEMENTATION WILL DECREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS RECEIVING TIER 2 AND TIER 3 SERVICES IN GRADES 4-8 BY 15 PERCENT.
