There are 3 positions (AIA, Social Worker, Certified Teacher @ OCES) currently funded by ESSER funds, those funds will be exhausted at the conclusion of 2022-23. TLEC is preparing to work those costs into future budgeting plans.

TLEC administrators also relayed that the TLEC office will be looking at some costs associated with maintenance and upkeep of the facility in coming years.

- A. Medicaid Cost Settlement funds requested by the state that TLEC returned in September, have been received, and remained the same figures received prior.
- B. As of the December meetings, TLEC has received 2 of the 6 (454,456) PreK MOUs. At this point, PreK numbers are at a level that if maintained, TLEC administration does not anticipate billing for additional costs as outlined in the PreK MOUs.
