Kindergarten: Phoneme Segmentation

First: Nonsense Word Fluency

Second: Oral Reading Fluency - rate and accuracy

Third: Oral Reading Fluency - rate and accuracy

Eighth: Comprehension Assessment

ACT: The ACT is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions.

ACT Workkeys: ACT WorkKeys is an assessment that tests students' job skills in applied reading, writing, mathematics, and Essential Skills.

Scores are based on job profiles that help employers select, hire, train, develop, and retain a high-performance workforce.

ASQ - Ages and Stages Questionnaire, provides reliable, accurate developmental and social-emotional screening for children between birth and age 6. This assessment screens and assesses the developmental performance of children in the areas of communication, gross motor skills, problem-solving, and personal-social skills. It is used to identify children that would benefit from in-depth evaluation for developmental delays.

DLM: Dynamic Learning Maps® (DLM®) alternate assessment to test students with the most significant cognitive disabilities

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FastBridge Developmental Milestones- PK- IN LAB

FastBridge Math - assessments combine research-based Computer Adaptive Tests (CAT) for universal screening and highly sensitive Curriculum-Based Measures (CBM) for progress monitoring to quickly deliver accurate, actionable data.

FASTTrack Reading - FASTtrack Reading includes **specific assessments students complete three times a year for universal screening**. FastBridge has pre-selected the specific assessments based on their capacity to predict future student reading performance and indicate what type of reading instruction is needed now.

FASTTrack Math - FASTtrack Math **provides teachers with easy access to the FastBridge recommended math screening assessments for each grade level**. FASTtrack Math includes two specific assessments students complete three times a year for universal screening.

FastBridge Sabers: The SAEBRS (Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Risk Screener) is **a brief, norm-referenced tool for screening all students to identify those who are at risk for social-emotional behavior (SEB) problems**

HGSS Assessment: The Kansas Social Studies Classroom Based Assessment (CBA) is designed to measure these standards and benchmarks and it allows local districts, classroom teachers, and students to design their own product that demonstrates student understanding of the Standards and Benchmarks.

KAP: Kansas State Assessment The English language arts (ELA), mathematics, and science assessments are part of the federal elementary and secondary education legislation
