The preschool has had very little turnover in the past 5 years but we know that it is important to support our teachers and advocate for their job satisfaction. Teachers at SAC are very a close group and and learn together each and every day. One way we have supported their professional growth is to create grant opportunities for Dana Workman and Amber Gist (para professional) to continue their education and receive their teaching licenses. Both of them have received \$10,000 and are enrolled to start their course work this summer.
