SUMMER SCHOOL

We have 60 students enrolled in summer school. School will occur from May 30-June 16th. Shuttles run from Little Steps, CAC and SAC. If students live in Overbrook they are transported by their parents.

Important Details:

Breakfast and Lunch will be provided at no cost for all students

Classes will be held at Overbrook Attendance Center from 8:00-11:45am

All students will receive daily social-emotional lessons. Students will be attending the following rotations during the summer school day:

Rotation 1: Number Corner

Rotation 2: Phonics

Rotation 3: Decodable Text & Word Work

Rotation 4: Math

Description Key:

Number Corner: a 20m whole group math skills practice with a quick-paced warm-up and calendar component to reinforce and extend skills and concepts in real-world context.

Phonics: small-group, strategic instruction delivered explicitly and systematically in one or several specific areas to address targeted gaps in phonics skills

Decodable Text & Word Work: sequenced text to progressively incorporate words that are consistent with the letter-sound relationships that have been taught to the reader

Math: Bridges in Mathematics: supplemental, explicit small-group instruction; each lesson includes a warm-up, game or activity, and a guided practice page.

BOE GOAL 5: FACILITIES UPDATE

Summer projects are already underway. The roof to the annex is complete.
