Details: The plan is to do a gift card raffle in which student athletes sell tickets for the raffle. If you were on the team last year, it is a very similar fundraiser. There will be two winners for the entire bunch of gift cards. The cards for the two winners will be distributed as evenly as possible. The idea is to be able to do a fundraiser that is efficient and effective. Students will be given the details in a meeting in the fall, probably October, and then be given time to sell tickets. We will complete the drawing before the end of the first semester, probably at a home basketball game.

If players/parents are willing to donate a gift card for the raffle that would be fantastic! This is NOT mandatory. If you are able and willing to donate one then that is great, if not, then no worries. If you do donate a gift card, here is what we ask:

- The gift card is current (does not expire until at least the end of the calendar year)
- The gift card is not used
- The gift card is appropriate for all ages

Cost of the tickets:

\$5 per ticket or 5 tickets for \$20

Goal:

If we are able to raise money for the team, it will allow the team to purchase nice gear for the students such as sweatshirts, practice shirts, etc. By completing the fundraiser in the fall, this will give us time to order this gear, as well as have a much better understanding of our budget going into the season. We will also complete the drawing prior to winter break.
